Moodle is a free Learning Management System, available via their website or via their app (Apple iOS, Android or Windows). It allows you to create online classrooms, which house resources, activities,

assignments, games, forums, wikis, and many other features.

I have used Moodle as an accompaniment to my courses, where I upload all course materials and assignments, as well as provide forums for Q & A help, or to discuss concepts covered in class.



Moodle covers many of the cognitive levels of Bloom's Taxonomy. For example, students can use it to recall information or test their knowledge in quizzes ('Remembering'), they can write about what they understand ('Understanding'), and they can collaborate with others, discussing and debating ('Evaluating') (Carrington, 2015; Schrock, 2015; Wilson, 2013).
