Twitter is a free microblogging tool, available via [the web](#) or via their app (Apple or Android). Messages are limited to 140 characters and they can be replied to, liked or retweeted (forwarded).

Twitter can be used in education for brainstorming, sharing and retweeting resources, collaborating on topics via hashtags, or to request help (Kimball, 2016). I have also used Twitter to tweet about conferences I've helped organised or attended, I have retweeted funny German photos, and I have also used it to connect to German sports athletes, like tennis player Andre Begemann.

Twitter fits under the 'Remembering' and 'Understanding' cognitive levels of Bloom's Taxonomy, as students can classify, respond to and expand tweets (Carrington, 2015; Schrock, 2015; Wilson, 2013).
